Solar Utility Project Engagement Sessions





Throughout July MRSB and Coles Associates meet with community members to begin engagement opportunities on the design and development of a 6MW Solar Utility Farm. Events held include: several individual interviews, a youth engagement session, and two engagement sessions in Scotchfort and Rocky Point. At the youth engagement session, three potential logo/name designs for the project were developed. A Facebook poll took place in the Abegweit First Nation: Community Noticeboard from July 17-22nd to determine the communities preferred design to be fully developed. More engagement opportunities related to the 6MW Solar Utility Project will take place in the fall stay tuned for the information!

Energy Minerals and Mines Conference







From July 9th to 11th, 2025 at Delta Prince Edward Island an Energy, Minerals and Mines Conference was hosted. Chief Gould attended the pre-Indigenous conference and had an opportunity to share the several clean energy initiatives Abegweit First Nation completed, as well as those that are on-going. The collaborative session offered an opportunity for Indigenous Leadership and Federal, Provincial and Territorial Ministers to explore shared perspectives and insights related to the conferences theme -Securing the Future of Canada's Energy and Mining Sectors.

Prior to the conference, Chief Gould invited Assistant Deputy Minister Kimberly Lavoie, Minister of Natural Resources Canada and Nishu Gulati, Partnership and Engagement Director General with Natural Resources Canada for a tour throughout the community.
