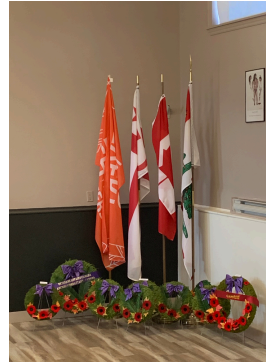


## Indigenous Veterans Day

Elder - Doreen Jenkins opened the ceremony with a prayer, Lone Cry drum group played the Honour Song and community youth - Kiara Coade read a poem that she wrote about the Indigenous Veterans Day for the Mi'kmaq people and how they fought in the war, even though they weren't considered Canadian at that point in time.
